

Pupil Charter

- You will be given different times to come to school. On your way to school keep 2 metres away from people who are not in your family.
- When you get here, follow the in and out lines and wait in line outside school on the 2m markers.
- Enter the school when asked and your teacher will be ready to send you to wash your hands or you will be given hand sanitiser.
- You will wash your hands using soap or sanitiser when you arrive at school, before you eat a meal, before and after any playtimes, if you cough or sneeze, after you have been to the toilet and before you go home.
- **Remember** to sing 'Happy Birthday' twice. There will be posters by the sinks to help you remember. Dry your hands carefully so that they do not become sore.
- If you cough or sneeze 'CATCH IT, BIN IT, KILL IT' Catch it in a tissue, put the tissue in the bin then wash your hands with soap or sanitiser.
- You must not cough, sneeze or spit near another person.
- You will be in small groups of up to 15 children instead of big classes. You must stay in these groups with your teacher, even if it is a different teacher to normal.
- You must not interact with children in the other groups.
- You must not touch any other children or any members of staff.
- Your break and lunch times will be at different times and you will only be with children from your group.
- You must only use equipment given to you, you are not allowed to share equipment so please ask a grown up if you need something.
- Listen to your teacher when you leave the classroom. You will be told how to go to the toilets, to the hall and outside in a safe way.
- If you feel poorly with a cough or feel very hot please tell a teacher straight away so that we can help you.
- If you find any of the new rules difficult, the adults will help explain them to you and may talk to your parents to help you.
- If you are at home, you will need to work through the home learning as you have been doing.
- We will use Class Dojo to let your parents know how well you are doing. They will be able to see points being rewarded.
