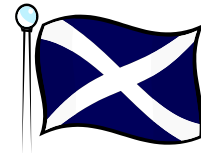


Drinks Bottles, Hats and Sun cream


