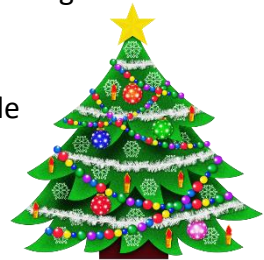
Christmas Fair Preparations
