These are the opening times:

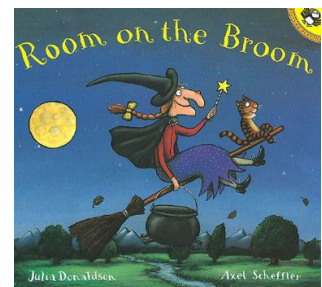
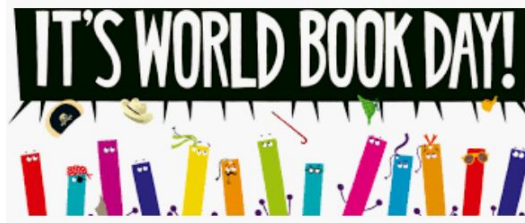
Thursday 5 th March	3.20-3.40 pm only
