If you recall, in my first newsletter of the year, I asked the children to arrive at school at the following times:

Reception: 8:50am

Year One: 8:50am (Children to enter through Year 1 outside area.)

Year Six: 8:50am

Reception Class and Classes One and Six to be in school by 9.00am.

Year Two: 9:00am

Year Three: 9:00am

Year Four: 9:00am

Year Five: 9:00am

Classes Two, Three, Four and Five to be in school by 9.10am. **9.10am gates close.**

I also said not to worry if you have children in two or more classes, with two different start times – they can come in at the earliest time together. I have noticed, lately however, that most children are in school by 9.00am. In normal circumstances this would be excellent. Whilst the current pandemic continues, it is vital we remember to socially distance. Could I ask you to adhere to the arrival times above please. I would greatly appreciate it if we could try to reduce crowding in and around the school premises at the start and end of the school day.

The school day will continue to end at 3.20pm. Thank you for following the one-way system. Please remember to socially distance yourselves as you move around the site.

Could I ask you not to linger on the school site or outside school on the pavement. I, too, have been guilty of chatting to parents and holding the flow of parents through the gate. If a conversation must take place, please keep at least 2 metres apart and be aware of people around you. Thank you for your continuing support.
