Important Changes From Monday 9th November 2020

From Monday, I would really appreciate it if parents and carers entering the school grounds could wear face coverings. This means the times you are:

- Dropping off your child at CHILL
- Dropping off your child in the mornings for school
- Picking up your child after school
- Picking up your child from CHILL
- Talking to a member of the office staff.

I have asked the teachers and support staff to wear face coverings (shields or masks) at the same times when parents are around school.

During the school day, all visitors will be asked to wear face coverings.

Lunchtime staff and staff moving between bubbles (classes) have been asked to wear face coverings.

CHILL staff have been asked to wear face coverings.

Teachers will not be asked to wear face coverings when they are with their own classes.

Flu Vaccine Information

Primary aged children are going to be offered the flu vaccine free of charge. Normally, parents and carers would receive a paper form to complete for your child to receive the vaccine. This year, due to Covid, parents and carers will be able to apply online. The link to apply is <https://forms.mpft.nhs.uk/>

You will need to enter this code **JBFSANDW**, which lets the vaccine team know which school your child is attending. Forms are to be submitted by Sunday 22nd November. Vaccinations will take place in school on Monday 23rd November.
