Flu Vaccine Information

Primary aged children are going to be offered the flu vaccine free of charge. Normally, parents and carers would receive a paper form to complete for your child to receive the vaccine. This year, due to Covid, parents and carers will be able to apply online. The link to apply is <https://forms.mpft.nhs.uk/>

You will need to enter this code **JBFSANDW**, which lets the vaccine team know which school your child is attending. Forms are to be submitted by Sunday 22nd November. Vaccinations will take place in school on Monday 23rd November. Copies of the flu vaccine letter and the "Protecting your child against flu" leaflet is attached to this newsletter and copies are available on the school website in the Newsletters Archive.

If you cannot access the vaccine form online, paper copies are available from the school office. For your child to receive the vaccine, you must give parental consent.
