

Parent Charter

- You must not send your child to school if they have any COVID-19 symptoms (Free testing is available).
- If your child falls ill in school with any symptoms you will be asked to pick them up immediately.
- Engage with the NHS test and trace system and inform school immediately of the results of a test.
- We strongly advise that you wear a face mask on site. They must be worn if entering any buildings.
- School start and finish times will be staggered. Please arrive and leave within your given time-slot.
- Do not congregate with other parents on or off the school site.
- When you get here, follow the directions given by floor markings and adults.
- Only one adult is allowed to accompany your child/children.
- You must stick to the 2m rule when waiting on the school premises and queuing outside.
- You will only be allowed to enter the school building if a prior appointment has been made. Enquiries/messages should be sent via Class Dojo, e-mail or you can ring the school.
- If you do have an appointment you must wash or sanitise your hands on entering the premises and stick to the 2m rule.
- Please read through the pupil charter with your child before they return to school and check that they understand the rules.
- If possible, please provide the children with a set of colours, pens, pencils, rubber etc. and place in a wipe-able tub that they can keep in school.
- Please only allow your child to bring essential equipment to school.
- Please dress your child in clothes and shoes they can remove and put back on themselves.
- Please only put items in lunch boxes that children can open themselves.
- Ensure that all children have a PE kit which can be worn outdoors in all weathers.
