Class Numbers In September

Earlier in the year, I wrote to all parents and carers informing you that, from September, the numbers of classes in school would reduce from seven classes to six classes. This week, I received the names of the children who will be joining St Andrew's in September. I can now confirm how classes they will be arranged. From September, the 6 classes will be organised as follows:

- Reception Children mixed with Year 1 children
- Year 1 children mixed with Year 2 children
- Year 3 children will be in a single class
- Year 4 children will be in a single class
- Year 5 children will be in a single class
- Year 6 children will be in a single class

In essence, the current Reception children will be divided into two groups. One group will join Reception children and the other group will join Year 2 children. It is important to note that all children will be taught according to their stage and not their age. At this point, I cannot say which Year 1 child will join the Reception group and which will join the Year 2 group.

Easter Break Play Days

It was lovely to see the children during the Easter break. 80 children attended the clubs over the two days (half the school!). Premier Education commented on how well the children behaved, on their excellent manners and on their willingness to join in. I would like to offer some provision during the summer half term break but I just need to be cautious in case government guidance says otherwise. I will keep you posted over the forthcoming weeks.
