### This week in school...



On Thursday it was Remembrance Day. At the memorial stone in Weston, the children from **Willow and Oak Classes** recited a poem they had learned. For many of the children, it was their first public performance. They did really well.


This week, the children in **Beech Class** wrote a lovely remembrance poem to perform at the service on Thursday. They read it beautifully and with great respect. Well done Beech. In geography, children have turned their sketch maps of local areas into information maps with keys. In science, they have started learning about light. Many children found out that the Moon is not actually a light source but reflects light from the Sun – an important new fact! The week finished with Group 2 having their first Forest School session and Group 1 having their first dance lesson in PE.

**Elm Class** has enjoyed finding the perimeter of shapes in maths this week. In English, the children have been planning a fable based on Aesop's fables. They have shown a great deal of imagination. The children also noticed that the morals in the fables are similar to our own school values.



This week in **Sycamore Class**, the children have used their art skills to create poppies to make a whole class wreath and have made beautiful Remembrance Day pictures. They focused on shading, use of colour, blending and different lines to create some stunning pictures. They should be really proud of themselves and the effort they have put into their work.





Another week has flown by in **Maple Class**. The children created some beautiful and thoughtful pieces of art linked to Remembrance Day and performed 'In Flanders Fields' by John McCrae and an extract from 'For the Fallen' by Laurence Binyon at our Remembrance Service. We were very proud of the way they conducted themselves.
